Many have appreciated that teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications, institutes conduct remedial classes, teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem based learning for enhancing learning experiences. Teachers encourage students to express and clarify their doubts in class. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching and fairness in evaluation. Most of the students were satisfied with the syllabus covered and the teaching style of the teachers

They also expressed satisfaction on the infrastructure of eco-friendly nature of the building and its environs that made them feel close to nature, the teaching halls and audiovisual facilities available in the college.

The result analysis shows that majority of the students have highly appreciated the facilities available in the institution very positively. We also observed some comments, which will help us to improve ourselves in some aspects.
