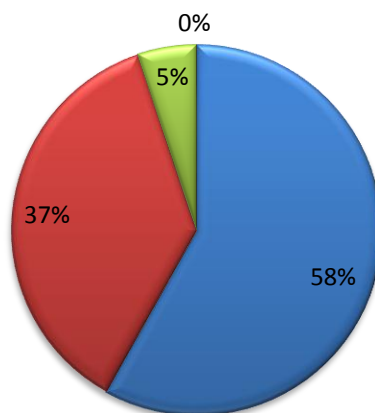

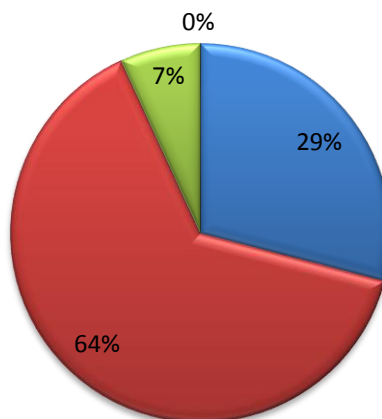
1. Is curriculum easy to understand?

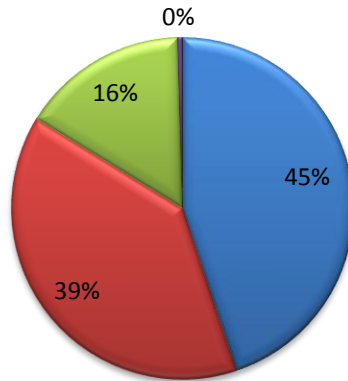
2. Is Curriculum completed within prescribed duration?

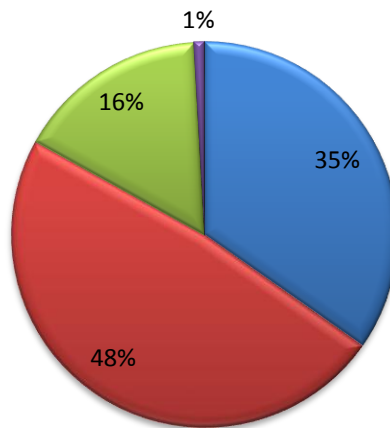
03. Does the Curriculum give you sufficient & necessary knowledge with respect to future career opportunities?

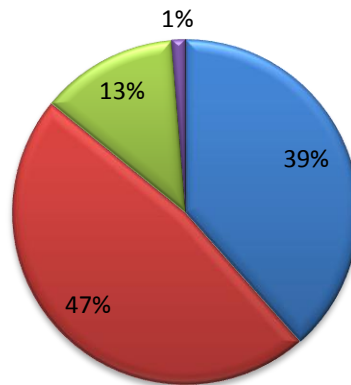
04. Is Current Syllabus useful to provide Job opportunity?

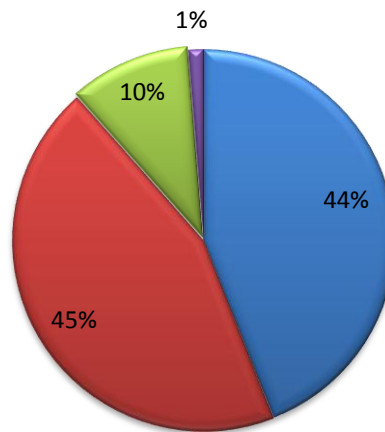
05. Are some points in the curriculum taught with the help of ICT?

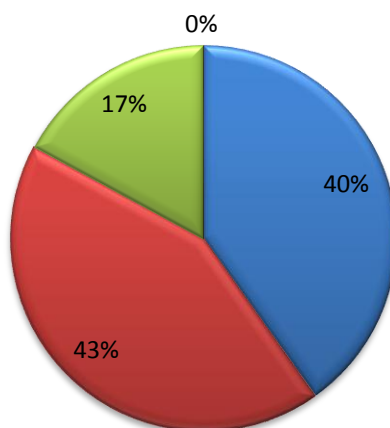
06. Need of CBCS pattern in Curriculum

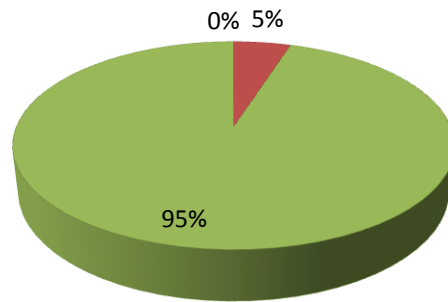
Following was the response of the students for the questionnaire asked:

- 234 students' feedbacks were collected and analysed.
- 58% of the students rated the syllabus is Excellent to understand and whereas 05% students rated the syllabus is Satisfactory to understand.
- 64% students rated that Curriculum completed within prescribed duration.
- Out of 234 students 105 students rated the Curriculum is excellent to give sufficient & necessary knowledge with respect to future career opportunities.
- 48% students rated that Current Syllabus good to provide Job opportunity and 07% are satisfied with Syllabus.
- 47% Students said that the curriculum taught with the help of ICT.
- Out of 234 students 207 students stated the need of CBCS Syllabus.

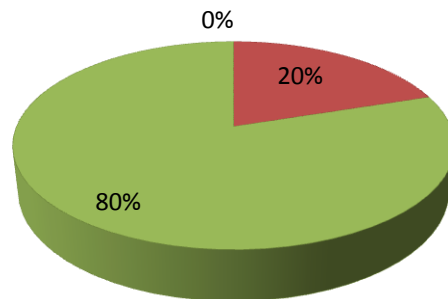

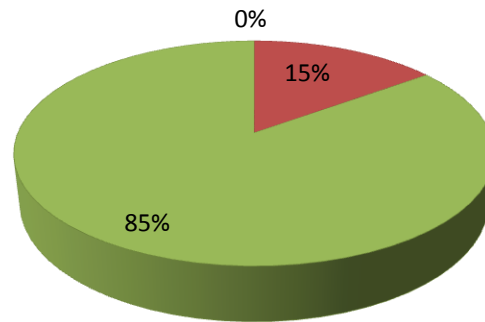
The syllabus has good balance between theory and practical application

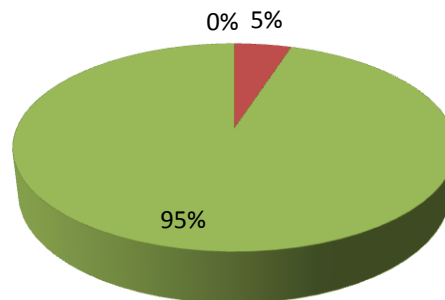

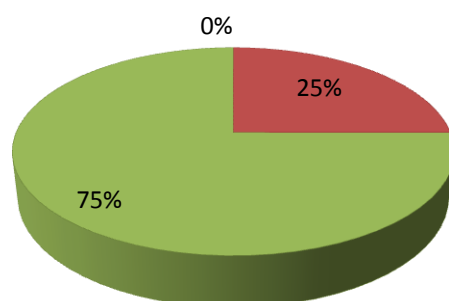

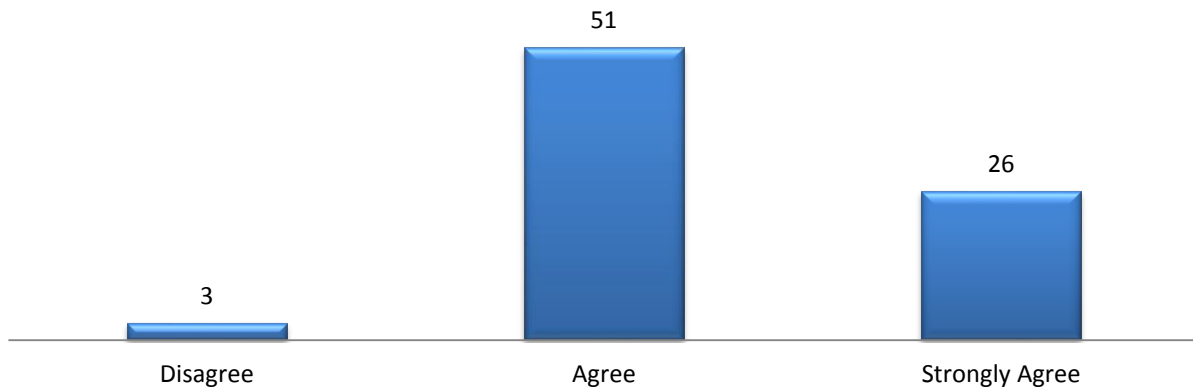
Analysis:

- According to 70% teachers there is freedom to adopt new techniques/ strategies of testing and assessment of student

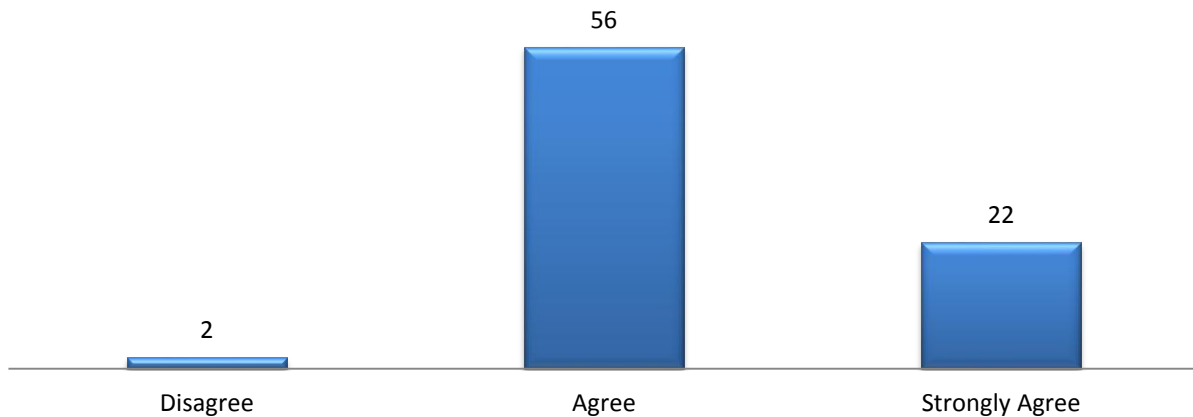








- 80 feedbacks from alumni were collected and analysed.


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
